RESOLUTION NO. 2018-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HONEY BROOK, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING SERVICE FEES TO BE CHARGED PURSUANT TO THE TOWNSHIP'S FALSE ALARM ORDINANCE, AS CODIFIED AT CHAPTER 6, PART 2.

WHEREAS, the Township has adopted an ordinance to regulate and impose service fees upon properties from which repeated false alarms emanate, as codified in the Honey Brook Township Code of Ordinances at Chapter 6, Part 2, which ordinance authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish such service fees by resolution.


BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Honey Brook that the following service fees shall be assessed against the owner of any property that violates the Township's false alarm ordinance, as codified at Chapter 6, Part 2 of the Township's Code of Ordinances:

False alarms for single-family dwellings	
1st false alarm per calendar year	Warning
2nd false alarm per calendar year	\$125 per alarm
3rd false alarm per calendar year	\$250 per alarm
4th false alarm per calendar year	\$500 per alarm
5th & subsequent false alarm per calendar year	\$1,000 per alarm
False alarms for multi-family and non-residential	
1st false alarm per calendar year	Warning
2nd false alarm per calendar year	\$250 per alarm
3rd false alarm per calendar year	\$500 per alarm
4th false alarm per calendar year	\$1,000 per alarm
5th & subsequent false alarm per calendar year	\$2,000 per alarm

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses,
