

NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP

The Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing on Monday, January 7, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in the Honey Brook Township Building located at 500 Suplee Road, Honey Brook, PA 19344 in Honey Brook Township, for the purpose of considering and rendering a decision with respect to an Application for Conditional Use submitted by James Haigney, Project Manager, Commonwealth Engineers, Inc., Agent on behalf of Amos K. Kauffman & Elizabeth Kauffman in accordance with Chapter 27, Part 8, Section 805.D(2)(b) (iv) of the Honey Brook Township Zoning Ordinance of 2003 and the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (53 P.S. § 10101, et seq.). The property is located in the A-Agricultural Zoning District. The Application for Conditional Use, if approved by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township, would allow the Applicant to construct a play/recreation area for a school. A portion of the proposed play/recreation area will be located in a Zone Two Riparian Buffer on property located at 2069 Beaver Dam Road. An existing metal building, three sheds and a stone driveway exist on the property and will remain on the property.

All interested persons may appear and be heard at the above time and place. Complete copies of the full text of the Conditional Use Application, Zoning Ordinance, and Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code are on file and may be examined without charge or obtained for a charge not greater than the cost of copying thereof at the Honey Brook Township Building during regular office hours.
