

2018-2019 Manure Management Planning Workshops

Chapter 91 Manure Management Plans are written plans required as part of the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law for all animal operations, regardless of scale, that generate or land apply manure. This includes:

- ◆ Dairy Farms
- ◆ Personal (small) and larger commercial equine operations
- ◆ All pasture beef/goat/sheep operations
- ◆ Poultry operations
- ◆ Swine operations
- ◆ Crop farms where manure is imported

The Chester County Conservation District is hosting Manure Management Workshops to:

- ◆ Educate and inform landowners/operators of Pennsylvania's Manure Management regulations and requirements, and what it means for you
- ◆ Assist in the development of written Manure Management Plans for your operation to responsibly manage nutrient sources to protect clean water and for compliance with state law.
