- WHO?** To be eligible for food pantry distributions, participants must be residents of Chester County and living in the Twin Valley School District or Indian Run Community and the participant's total household income is at or below 150% poverty level as determined by the Federal government. Participants must show a bill or other official document with their address. A driver's license is acceptable but a bill is preferred. The pantry reserves the right to refuse service.
- WHAT?** Clients will receive non-perishable items, dairy, meat and fresh produce. Food will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis.
- WHERE?** Good Food Distribution Center at 5064 Horseshoe Pike, Honey Brook. Just two blocks west of the traffic light at Route 322 and Route 10, across from Wimpy & Dee's Diner.
- WHEN?** The 2nd Wednesday of every month from 10:00 AM – 1:00 PM.
The 4th Wednesday of every month from 4:00 – 6:30 PM
Residents may visit the pantry once a month.
